Here is where we ask ourselves what happened? Context is king here. Read over the selected verses/chapters multiple times, pull in other translations, cross references, and jot down initial thoughts

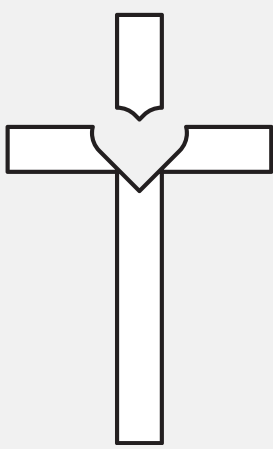
COMPREHENDING
